

More Information & What to Bring:

The Peyote Gardens are situated in the Tamaulipan thornscrub environment. The relatives that live among the Medicine have thorns/spines. We recommend thick clothing and sturdy boots.

Weather Forecast:

- Day Highs ~75 degrees
- Night Lows ~52 degrees

Clothes:

- Warm layers
- Sturdy shoes/boots/protection from harsh elements (ie. cactus)
- Hat/Sun protection
- Poncho or Raincoat
